Admission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> After students are notified that the application is approved, they will receive further information later in the semester. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Admission Notice (around mid-May or mid-December); Visa Application for Study in China (around mid-May or mid-December); Course Schedule(around late June or late December); International Student Guide-a comprehensive guide that includes (but is not limited to) registration, orientation, housing, insurance, visa, academic affairs, transportation, overall schedule, etc. (around early July or early January) Please be aware that the timetable provided is approximate and subject to change.
Before Arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All students are required to apply for a Student Visa (X visa) at the Chinese Embassy or Consulate in their country with their passport, Admission Notice, and Visa Application for Study in China. Work Permit: NO

After Arrival	Exchange students are generally recommended to arrive a few days ahead of each semester officially begins. Please follow the schedule provided in the International Student Guide once it has been shared.						
Courseload	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please follow the specific requirements set by your home university during the exchange period. • On average, exchange students take 4 -20 credits per semester. 						
Course Registration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The course registration system will officially open on the first day of the new semester. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Undergraduate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The course registration period usually lasts ONE week; - There are two stages during this time: (1) Adding/Dropping; (2) Adding ONLY - Students are able to withdraw ONE course (if needed) around mid-semester (shown as “W” on transcript). - Graduate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The course registration period usually lasts TWO weeks; - Students are able to add or drop courses during this time, but it is strongly NOT advised to drop courses (once the courses are chosen), so please think and plan carefully. - There is NO “withdrawal” option for graduate courses. - For English courses, students are free to choose offerings from ACEM’s MIB program (Master of International Business). But please note that the MBA program is run by a different office (MBA Center) with separate nominations and procedures. MBA courses are exclusively offered for their students only and are NOT open to regular graduate exchange students. • There is no limitation to choosing courses offered on different campuses. Exchange students are free to choose what best fits their study plans. • Once the course registration period passes, students CANNOT make any more changes to their course schedule. Please pay special attention to the specific deadlines once they are announced by ACEM’s exchange coordinator.
